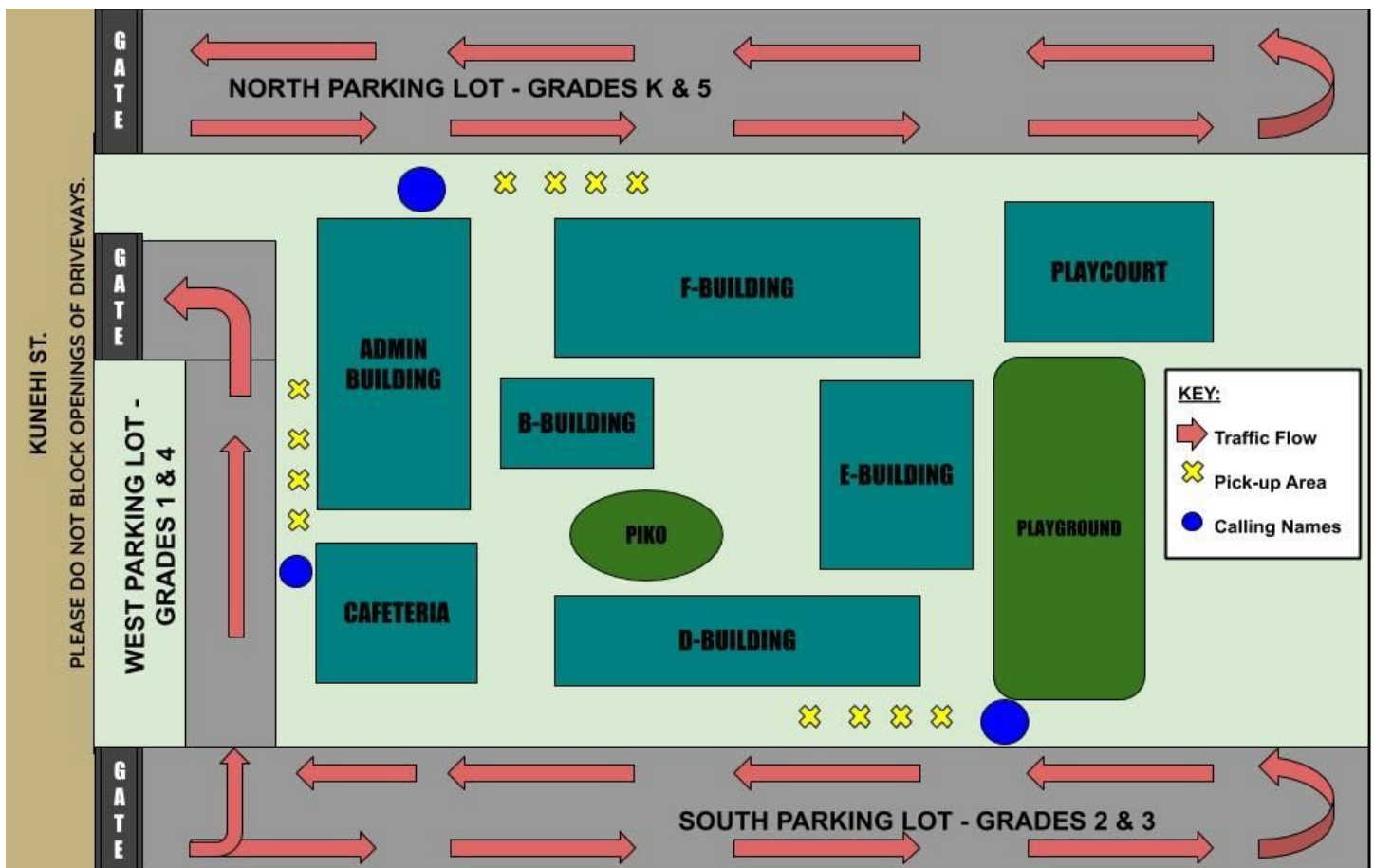

6. When your vehicle reaches the pick-up table, please pop open your trunk – we will place the supplies bag in your trunk and close it. Since you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle at any time, please make sure you prepare a space in your trunk for the bag ahead of time.
7. If you are unable to make it on this date, you may schedule a time with the office to pick up your resources.
8. Please be sure to print out the attached placard or write on an 8.5"x11" paper, your child's full name, grade level, and room number, and clearly display it on your dashboard.
